Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ -

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and from our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

We will begin our Holy Week observances with Palm Sunday on April 9th. If you arrive for worship Palm Sunday morning and find the sanctuary empty – don't worry. You will find us in the fellowship hall where we plan to gather for worship. After everyone has received a palm branch and/or ribbon wand, we will share in a brief scripture reading and prayer before processing into the sanctuary while singing "Jesus Loves Me."

In previous years, members of Saint Stephen have made the palm crosses we receive on Palm Sunday. This year the palm crosses you will receive were made by Christians living in seven small villages in Tanzania. The Tanzanian Christians who make these crosses are paid fair wages for their labor – often for the first time in their lives.

All of the net proceeds for the palm crosses are returned to East Africa in the form of grants designed to assist, encourage, empower, and to give hope to those who receive them. Some of the projects supported include agricultural and vocational training programs, the development of safe community water systems, and emergency relief for the victims of civil strife, drought, and other natural disasters. These crosses are changing lives in powerful ways.

Our palm crosses were donated by the Rita and Steven Sarson in memory and honor of their parents. The Sarson family also wishes to invite you to a very special ice cream social during coffee hour on Palm Sunday following our morning worship.

We will continue our Holy Week observances with our Maundy Thursday worship service with Holy Communion at 7:00 pm in the sanctuary on Thursday, April 13th.

We will remember our Lord's arrest, trial, and crucifixion on Good Friday, April 14th at 7:00 pm in the sanctuary.

We will gather to celebrate Jesus' triumphant resurrection from the dead at both 8:00 am and 10:00 am on Easter, April 16th.

Our fellowship committee is hosting what is certain to be a delicious Easter breakfast between the two worship services starting at 9:00 am.

Our senior youth are hosting an Easter egg hunt following our 10:00 am worship Easter morning for the children of Saint Stephen.

I look forward to worshiping our Lord with you.


