Time to Make Operation Christmas Child Boxes!

While you are out buying school supplies with your children or grandchildren, consider buying a few extra items for building Operation Christmas Child boxes. The Final Collection Sunday for Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes at St. Stephen is November 20th, so there is plenty of time to get your shoebox(es) together. These shoeboxes are sent to one of the eight distribution centers around the USA and then shipped to children in war zones, disaster areas, and areas of extreme poverty around the world. In 2015, over 11 million OCC shoeboxes were sent to children in 109 countries. If you have never packed a shoebox for Operation Christmas Child, start by

- Getting a cardboard or plastic shoebox with removable lid (average size). If the box is cardboard, wrap the lid and box separately. If the plastic box is clear, line the plastic box with fabric, a bandana, wrapping paper, or a T-shirt.
- 2. Select a toy that a child will cherish, like a doll or plush stuffed animal.
- 3. Fill the box with other fun small toys, hygiene items (toothbrushes, bar soap, washcloths, combs), and school supplies (pencils, sharpeners, pens, crayons, notebooks, coloring books).
- 4. Pray for the child(ren) receiving your box(es).
- 5. Include a \$7 donation (check preferred) to cover shipping costs for each box.
- 6. Secure your box with one or two rubber bands. (We have them at the church, if you don't.)
- 7. Bring your box to St. Stephen before November 20th with either a "Boy" label or a "Girl" label taped to the top. You can get labels in the brochures that will soon be available in the narthex. Check the age group on the label that is most appropriate for the items in your box.

Join in the fun and start building your box now! Watch for the brochures and display table to appear in the narthex soon.

Sanctuary Sound System

Have you noticed the improved sound in the sanctuary? Early in July, Brenda Firquin met with the sound engineers who originally installed our sound system and organ in the new sanctuary. The service call was placed because problems with the main monitor made it impossible to use. After considerable testing, the engineers determined the problem was the result of many improper and unnecessary adjustments made to our sound system. After several hours of intense work, the system has been adjusted and all sound components recalibrated, including the microphones. PLEASE NOTE: Our sound system is simple to operate and requires the use of ONE <u>power switch</u>. The only adjustments that should ever be necessary are to *increase or decrease volume*, using ONLY the <u>slider buttons</u> clearly marked on the sound board. Please do not make any other changes to the sound board or any of the components, including the CD player. The main power switch controls the entire system and is clearly marked. All other power switches should be left in the "on" position. If you feel something needs to be adjusted, please speak to Brenda Firquin or one of the Worship Coordinators. They have received information on properly operating the sound system. Thank you for your assistance.
