Did you know 1 in 5 children in our community lacks enough food to live an active, healthy lifestyle?

Did you know 64% of Jefferson County Public School students received reduced price breakfast and/or lunch (0 to 40¢) every school day during the 2013-2014 school year?

Did you know many elementary school students receive a backpack every Friday afternoon with nutritious food for the weekend, but that is only during the school year?

Over the summer these children and their families must rely on other sources for food like the Food Pantry at Fern Creek/Highview United Ministries. Unfortunately, the Food Pantry inventory at FCHUM is at its lowest levels during the summer months. During those times the amount of food a family receives is much less than during other times of the year.

We can make a difference. We can share God's incredible love with our neighbors. We can be God's hands in our community. Now through Saturday, June 11<sup>th</sup> the Fern Creek/Highview United Ministries has asked Saint Stephen to collect <u>canned chili</u> for the "Can for Kids" Food Drive.

The need for nutritious food like <u>canned chili</u> is great. Help us make sure every child served by the Fern Creek/Highview United Ministries' Food Pantry has as much food as possible this summer. Let's see how many cans of chili we can gather and see how many folks we can help feed.

#### **New Members Welcomed**


