Celebrate Pentecost by wearing red or other "fire" colors on **Sunday, June 9th** to commemorate the descent of the <u>Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u> upon the <u>Apostles</u> and other followers of <u>Jesus Christ</u> while they were in Jerusalem celebrating the <u>Feast of Weeks</u>, as described in the <u>Acts of the Apostles</u> (<u>Acts 2:1–31</u>). This event is often referenced when describing the birth of the early Christian church.


